

A NOTE FROM THE **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR**



Like all theatres across the world, Northlight shut down in March of 2020 due to the worldwide pandemic. It was a moment of crisis for us but also a moment of opportunity.

From the beginning of the pandemic, after discussion with our staff and Board of Trustees, Northlight decided to retain our staff and not take the route of layoffs of our employees. This proved to be a good decision because when the pandemic started to subside, we were ready to resume full productions and operation with our same seasoned staff.

We took the opportunity during the shutdown to build our Board of Trustees, create a long-term commitment to EDI issues, program our artistic work through internet programming, reach over 4,000 students through our educational work online, and secure the purchase of property in downtown Evanston, destined to be our new home in the future.

Since resuming operations in September of 2021, we have seen the return of audiences over the last two years, with a 38% increase in single ticket buyers from the 2021-22 to the 2022-23 season. Also this past season, Northlight extended two of the last three productions due to audience demand.

There is still recovery to be made with audiences and donors but Northlight is on solid footing for future growth and excellence. We are grateful to our patrons and loyal donors for their remarkable support during these challenging times. Thanks to Northlight's leadership, staff, board of trustees, and advisory council members, Northlight looks to the future with great anticipation of amazing things to come.












ARTS FOR EVERYONE





NEW STAFF ROLES

During the 2022-23 season, Northlight introduced two new staff positions: the Associate Artistic Director and the Human Resources Manager.



HUMAN RESOURCES MANAGER

Working under the supervision of the Artistic Director, the Associate Artistic Director is a senior level position working in partnership with the Artistic Director to curate and implement all artistic programming. This includes season selection; cultivating and managing artist relationships; curating & managing Interplay readings and workshops; addressing rehearsal needs; and actively participating in audience engagement and outreach initiatives. This position serves as one of the public faces of the Artistic team of the theatre.

Working under the supervision of the Managing Director, the Human Resources Manager manages all aspects of Human Resources for the company, including managing hiring and termination processes; maintaining the Employee Handbook and personnel files; and managing all employee benefit programs. This position is responsible for all payroll functions, including the submission of weekly payroll. The Human Resources & Payroll Manager is the permanent co-chair of the Equity, Diversity & Inclusion (EDI) Committee and is responsible for managing all EDI programs at the theatre.

NORTHLIGHT'S NEXT ACT

Over the last 12 months, Northlight has worked with Eckenhoff Saunders Architects, Bulley & Andrews General Contractors, Schuler Shook Theatrical Consultants, and other partners including Evanston-based firms Grumman Butkus and Teska Associates to complete the design for Northlight's new home in Evanston. Construction drawings were sent out to bid in July in anticipation of breaking ground in 2024. The Barn Steakhouse remains open and active on the rear of the property.

Northlight's future home in downtown Evanston will be a dynamic performance, event, and educational environment that will serve Evanston, Chicago, and the entire Chicagoland area long into the future. As of August 2023 we have raised 65% of the fundraising goal. We are grateful for support received from the Illinois Arts Alliance, the City of Evanston, the State of Illinois, and many generous individual donors as we move forward with this exciting and transformative project.
